

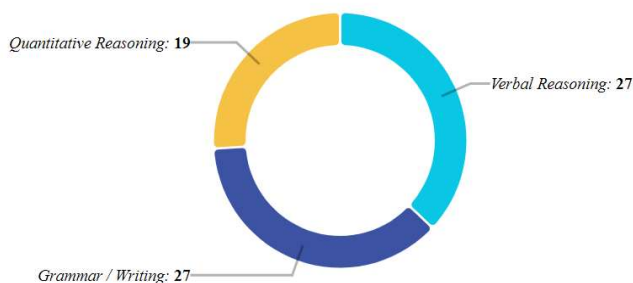
## Score Summary

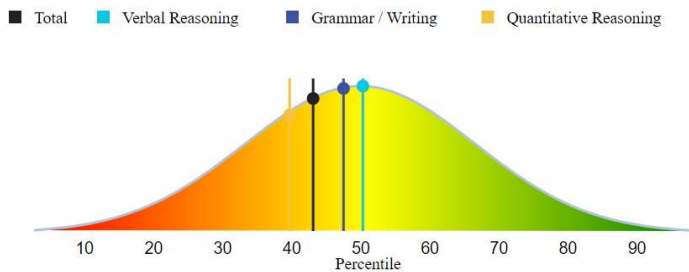
